If you recall from our Newsletter of 2021, one of the opportunities we were challenged to meet was “how to provide services for our clients during mandatory government closures?” Our solution was to purchase *BrightCourse*, a subscription-based video streaming service which provides a Bible-based curriculum on topics of Prenatal and Pregnancy Care, Healthy Relationships and Life Skills. The purchase of this year’s subscription was made possible through the generous donation of one of our patrons.

Now that *BrightCourse* is up, running, and capable of live streaming up to 5 videos at one time, mentors can set up video-streaming educational modules and supporting materials for a client or clients anytime, while incorporating personal phone contact. The client now has the freedom to choose the best time to study assignments so as not to conflict with work, family, or the Center’s hours of operation. *BrightCourse* also allows the client to virtually shop in our Boutique. The selected items are then packaged for pick-up or delivery as requested by the client.

*BrightCourse* is providing us with the ability and availability to educate more clients, in their home or at the Center, thus giving us a greater opportunity to “Save the Lives of the Unborn.”

Once again, I thank our generous donor for purchasing this year’s subscription! We pray that this new program can continue to be supported by our patrons as it has garnered rave reviews from both mentors and clients alike, making a positive difference in many lives.
