

VOLUNTEER PROFILE – Cathy Moyer



CATHY MOYER began volunteering at Harbor Lights Pregnancy & Information Center in March of 2018. Cathy came to us from the state of Florida. She had had a busy career working for Disneyland in Marketing. The abilities that that job required ended abruptly at the age of 39 when she suffered a stroke. Cathy was concerned about her limitations and what she would be able to do at the Center.

Cathy faced many losses: inability to talk and limited mobility. Her challenges were enormous. The Doctor told her that when most people suffer a stroke it is in a specific area of the brain. Cathy was told that the extent of her brain damage “was like putting her brain in a blender and pushing the frappe button.” Her brain was sending signals in all different directions, scrambling her thought processes.

Cathy chose to journey with Christ on her road to recovery. She acknowledges that not only did Christ sacrifice himself on the Cross to redeem her soul for all eternity; He, Jehovah Roephe, is the One who is healing her! (In Hebrew, raphe means “to completely make whole, to thoroughly mend and repair.”) Cathy acknowledges that He is the Great Physician!



Through numerous months/years of Speech, Physical and Occupational therapy she claimed the promise in Isaiah 41:13 “For I am the Lord your God who takes hold of your right hand and says to you, ‘Do not fear; I will help you.’”
